Fund Description

The BMO Barclays Global High Yield Bond (GBP Hedged) ETF is a global high yield debt exchange-traded fund which seeks to replicate the performance of the Bloomberg Barclays Global High Yield Bond Corporate Very Liquid ex-144A Hedged to GBP Index. The index is a broad-based measure of global high yield corporate bonds, with debt issued by US and European corporations. The currency exposure is hedged back to Pound Sterling to neutralise currency fluctuations and ensure all returns are solely attributable to the bond exposure. The fund itself will look to buy all of the securities of the index at the assigned weights or at least a carefully selected sample which mimic the risk profile of the index while avoiding illiquidity issues. BMO began offering investment services in 1925 and its asset management arm launched its ETF business in 2009. The fund's pricing is highly competitive in the sector and it offers investors global diversification and a potentially high level of income.






Performance Relative to Peer Group
